Study of the medical sciences in Tübingen and Freiburg, Germany. For more than 20 years at Bayer AG, Institute for Toxicology (now Bayer Schering Pharma AG), Wuppertal, Germany

Professional life in Toxicology started with toxicological assessments mainly in the area of existing chemicals regulations and as study director for toxicological studies (acute toxicity, skin sensitization, repeated dose toxicity). Since 2002 head of the Department of Industrial Chemical Toxicology at Bayer AG (now "Product Stewardship Industrial Chemicals & Operations" at Bayer Schering Pharma AG).

Key activities today are REACH activities including toxicological hazard and risk assessments, classification issues as well as establishing of Occupational Exposure Limits, e.g. as a member of the DFG Senate Commission for the Investigation of Health Hazards of Chemical Compounds in the Work Area (MAK Commission), deputy member of the German Advisory Committee on Hazardous Substances (AGS; a Tripartite Committee advising the Federal Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs on occupational safety and health) and chairperson of the subcommittee on "Hazard Risk Assessment" of the German Advisory Committee on Hazardous Substances (UAIII; e.g. Hazard Assessment and proposal for Occupational Exposure Limits).
