MEDICHEM is affiliated to the International Commission on Occupational Health (ICOH). The MEDICHEM Board acts as the ICOH Scientific Committee on Occupational Health in the Chemical Industry (MEDICHEM). The ICOH is a non-governmental international organisation (NGO) having consultative status with the United Nations, the UN Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC), and the specialised Agencies of the UN (ILO and WHO). The ICOH can accredit representatives to any office of the UN and is included in the ILO special list of NGO's.

€ What is MEDICHEM?

MEDICHEM was established in 1972 by Prof. Dr. med. Dr. h. c. Alfred M. Thiess, Corporate Medical Director at the world's largest chemical company BASF in Ludwigshafen, Germany. It is the international scientific association focusing on occupational and environmental health in the production and handling of chemicals. MEDICHEM has a worldwide membership.

€ What are MEDICHEM's Objectives?

MEDICHEM's prime objective is international cooperation in those occupational and environmental health issues related to the production and use of chemicals that are of global concern and that are most effectively resolved through a globally co-ordinated approach.

MEDICHEM's underlying objective is to contribute to the prevention of adverse effects on employees, customers and the general public, arising from the production and handling of chemicals.

MEDICHEM is apolitical and is engaged in the scientific and technological aspects of occupational health rather than the formulation of national or company policies.

MEDICHEM recognizes each country's right to make its own decisions, but through the dissemination of reliable information contributes to the development of rational legislation in the field of occupational health.

€ Who can join MEDICHEM?

All occupational and environmental health professionals, such as occupational physicians, toxicologists, occupational hygienists, epidemiologists, occupational psychologists, safety engineers and managers, regulators, occupational health nurses, and others of graduate status with an interest in occupational and environmental health, whether from industry, university, government departments or institutions, are invited to apply for MEDICHEM Membership.
