

Short CV Michael Nasterlack

Dr. med. Michael Nasterlack, graduated in medicine at the University of Heidelberg in 1979, is a specialist in general medicine, occupational medicine, and environmental medicine. He had worked as a general practitioner for six years before he became Assistant Medical Director at the Institute of Occupational Medicine at the University of Heidelberg. In 1996 he joined the Occupational Medicine and Health Protection Department of BASF in Ludwigshafen (Germany), where he holds the position of an Associate Corporate Medical Director.

He is a member of various national and international scientific societies for occupational and environmental medicine, Board Member of the German Society of Occupational and Environmental Medicine (DGAUM) and Board Member of MEDICHEM, which acts as the Scientific Committee on Occupational Health in the Chemical Industry of the International Commission on Occupational Health (ICOH).

He holds teaching appointments for occupational sciences at the Faculty of Business Administration of the University of Mannheim, and for occupational medicine at the Mannheim Medical Faculty of the University of Heidelberg.
